This one-day workshop is designed to introduce participants to the universal principles inherent in the nature of horse-human healing. The horse's instinctual and intuitive capacities and their social nature create a safe, supportive environment in which we may experience ourselves as authentic, empowered and relational beings.

Horses have been partnering with humans in health and healing since the 1970's. Like humans, horses are social animals. They have defined roles within their herds. They are unique individuals with distinct personalities, attitudes and moods. Most importantly horses have the ability to mirror exactly what the human body language is telling them; which makes them especially powerful messengers facilitating self-awareness in deep and profound ways.

There are many accounts of life-changing experiences resulting from humans relating to horses as sentient beings.

- Learn to stay centered around goals and ambitions
- Let go of old stories and perspectives that block energy and purpose
- Re-frame and integrate new beliefs that support vitality
- Regain self-esteem and self-confidence
- Practice setting boundaries
- Explore practices for staying "right here" and "right now"
- Develop and honor the authentic self
- Nourish creativity and change
- Trust intuitive knowing.
- Improve communication skills (verbal and non-verbal)
- Deepen trust and respect for self and others
